Purisima Highlands, and other residual minor groundwater basins.

May 23, 2017 – 26 - Authorize the Auditor to process payment from the fiscal year 2016-17 Zone 4 budget to the Resource Conservation District of Santa Cruz County in the amount of \$50,176 for provision of services rendered to County of Santa Cruz staff and Santa Cruz County residents for projects and programs related to storm damage repair, cannabis cultivation, and natural resource management.
