## Studio Floor Plan Requirements

Draw to scale. Each item below must be drawn on plan AND described in a side bar or separate page.

1) Procedure area and equipment, including handwash sink

Procedure area must be separated from nail and hair activities by a wall. Handwash sink must be supplied with hot & cold running water through mixing faucet and have a wall mounted, covered touchless paper towel dispenser and pump soap.

2) Bathroom

Handwash sink must be supplied with hot & cold running water through mixing faucet and have a wall mounted, covered touchless paper towel dispenser and pump soap.

3) Sharps containers.

If Sharps mail back is used, show the location of the prepaid return shipping box. If any full containers are stored, show their location. A full sharps container may not be stored longer than 30 days without specific written permission from EHS.

4) Autoclave/decontamination room

Must be at least 5' away from any procedure area OR separated by a cleanable barrier. Include the decontamination sink, "hot & cold running water through mixing faucet, and covered touchless, wall mounted paper towel dispenser" on the plan.

5) Hot water heater size, fuel source, & location.

If the appliance is within a business other than the body art studio, please describe what will occur if and when the appliance does not work properly in your IPCP.

6) Finish surface details of these procedure area and bathroom must be on the plan and they all must be smooth, clean, and washable:

Walls Floors Ceiling Equipment surfaces

Brick, concrete block, rough concrete, rough plaster or heavily textured gypsum board are not acceptable

- 6) Employee break area
- 7) Locate the openable windows and door, including screens, on the plan. Facility must have either screened doors and openable, screened windows or air conditioning.
- 8) Home Studios must be separate from any residential areas used for sleeping, bathing, or meal preparation.

A body art facility associated with a residential dwelling shall have a separate entrance and toilet facility and shall not have a door allowing direct access between the body art facility and the residential dwelling.
